**SHIPS OF THE SEA MARITIME MUSEUM CELEBRATES ARTIST ARTHUR
BEAUMONT, OFFICIAL ARTIST OF THE U.S. NAVY**

What: Ships of the Sea Maritime Museum will be hosting a special celebration of artist Arthur Beaumont. The event will include a lecture by the featured artist's son Geoffrey, interactive WWII demonstrations, 32 action-packed paintings, photo opportunities with Rosie the Riveter and the *USS Indianapolis*, Liberty Ship display, 1940s inspired music, a book signing with James Irvine Swinden, president of The Irvine Museum in California, and a maritime-inspired signature cocktail.
